Description of THE ENGAGEMENT

DIHMRS will be the single authoritative source for individual personnel and military units across the Department of Defense, regardless of military service affiliation. The DIHMRS system will collect data on every aspect of a military service member’s career and maintain the data in a single, comprehensive record. Every individual will have access to their record via remote self service, including their pay and personnel information.

Defense Integrated Military Human Resource System (DIMHRS)

This system is designed to ensure service personnel and their families are provided for, and will enable continual updates to be made on an on-going basis. Once fully deployed, DIMHRS will support more than 3 million military personnel deployed globally and will be the largest, most complex enterprise resource planning (ERP) initiative ever launched. It has a "go live" start date of 2005. This long term contract will set a precedent in the global e-business arena and is expected to last through 2013.

Macro Solutions, was selected by Northrop Grumman, the prime contractor, to provide People Soft implementation expertise and highly experienced People Soft consultants with a variety of skills.

Currently we are providing the team with PeopleSoft functional Global Payroll expertise, and will be providing additional resources and expertise throughout the systems development life cycle. Macro Solutions will have a growing role with Northrop Grumman throughout the implementation.

As a result of the excellent work and high-quality deliverables that Northrop Grumman submitted during Phase I, the DIMHRS program office selected Northrop Grumman to be the single contractor for the Phase II Development and Implementation Program effort. Work on the Phase II effort commenced in September 2003, beginning with a re-evaluation of the updated joint requirements and a preliminary design walkthrough, which was completed ahead of schedule in December 2003. DIMHRS is managed by Northrop Grumman's IT sector with most of the work being performed in New Orleans.
